Moneta Pay POS Crosses 200 Restaurants and Expands Fiscal Compliance Across East Africa After a Decade of Zero Data Loss

*Nairobi-built restaurant POS expands tax-authority integrations from Kenya and Uganda to Zambia, Nigeria and the UAE, as more African restaurants digitise operations and tax reporting.*

NAIROBI, Kenya — Holocorp Ltd, the Nairobi-based company behind Moneta Pay POS, has announced that its restaurant point-of-sale system now serves over 200 restaurants across East Africa and has expanded its fiscal compliance engine to cover Kenya, Uganda, Zambia, Nigeria and the United Arab Emirates.

The milestone comes as restaurants across the continent face increasing pressure to digitise operations, comply with evolving tax authority requirements, and reconcile an expanding range of payment methods — from cash and card to M-PESA and other mobile money rails.

Moneta Pay POS, originally built in 2016 as PyPOS for a single Nairobi restaurant, has evolved into a complete restaurant management platform covering order management, waiter analytics, smart stock tracking, M-PESA reconciliation via KopoKopo, and real-time fiscal receipt submission to tax authorities including the Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) and the Uganda Revenue Authority (URA). The company rebranded to Moneta Pay in 2025 and rebuilt the platform from the ground up.

“African restaurants operate in a very specific reality: unreliable internet, M-PESA-first customers, mandatory fiscal compliance, and lunch rushes that demand sub-15-second order entry,” said Mr Kimotho, CEO of Holocorp Ltd. “We’ve spent a decade building for that reality, not importing a Western POS and retrofitting it. That’s why we’ve had zero data loss across the platform, and why restaurants like Olive Chain of Restaurants have stayed with us for over ten years.”

Ten years, zero data loss

Hot Dishes Restaurant, a six-branch Nairobi CBD operator, has run on the platform since 2016. Other long-running clients include Pals Restaurant, Olive Restaurant, Oliveira, Maa Dishes and Applegreen Restaurants — all Nairobi-based, all on the platform for between seven and ten years.

Across the full customer base of over 200 restaurants, Moneta Pay reports zero data loss incidents in more than a decade of operation.

Fiscal compliance expands beyond Kenya and Uganda

Moneta Pay POS now supports direct integration with four tax authorities:

Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) — eTIMS fiscal receipts with digital signatures and verification QR codes

Uganda Revenue Authority (URA) — fiscal receipt submission and digital signing

Zambia Revenue Authority (ZRA) — fiscal compliance module

Nigeria Federal Inland Revenue Service (FIRS) — fiscal compliance module

United Arab Emirates Federal Tax Authority (FTA) — tax calculation and compliance

The company's modular tax engine allows new jurisdictions to be added as requirements evolve, without requiring restaurants to replace their POS hardware or retrain their staff.

### **Built for how African restaurants actually operate**

The platform is designed to run offline, so that orders, kitchen ticket printing and payments continue when internet connectivity is lost — a common reality across the region. When connectivity is restored, data syncs automatically.

Key features include:

Keyboard-first order entry — cashiers place complete orders in under 15 seconds

M-PESA reconciliation via KopoKopo — buygoods payments match to open orders in real time

Smart Stock Engine — pattern-matching recipes auto-calculate ingredient consumption from sales, eliminating manual stock counts

Waiter performance analytics — orders-per-hour, revenue, idle-time heatmaps and full void audit trails

Remote access via secure VPN — owners check sales, menus and reports from anywhere worldwide at any time.

CCTV order overlay — Dahua camera integration ties transactions to footage for loss prevention

### **Availability and partnerships**

Moneta Pay POS is available on a 21-day full-experience free trial, with paid plans from KES 2,500 per month. The company also operates a Reseller Program for entrepreneurs and IT providers bringing new restaurants onto the platform.
